Dear Parents and Carers,

This week is yet another action packed one with a variety of great activities occurring. On Wednesday students will be entertained by our next Nexus Arts performance, a magic show performed by Elio. Starting at 9:10am, students will be heading to Room 7 to watch the show and I understand Elio will share how to perform one of his special tricks. Make sure you are early to school tomorrow so we don't miss out!

On Thursday 15th May, Eagle Point Primary School will be turning blue to acknowledge the important message behind Dolly Day. Although the official date of Dolly Day is Friday 9th May, we made the decision to hold this on a separate day so as not to interrupt Mother's Day preparations. All students, staff, families and community are invited to wear blue on Thursday to show support for the message 'Be Kind'. This year, students will be able to purchase a blue cupcake for \$2.50 (gluten free option available). The school does have a fundraising page open which can be found on the Dolly Day website or contributions can be given to classroom teachers who will collect the money so we can donate to this cause.

Then, on Friday 16th May it is Walk To School Safely day. All students and families are invited to participate, either walking from home to the bus stop, home to school, or join one of our walking school buses. The walking school buses will collect students from 2 locations meeting at 8:10am. Stop 1 is the corner of Lake Victoria Road and Forge Creek Road, thank you to Mrs. Bateson for coordinating this bus. The second bus will meet at the corner of Cardinal Drive and Tait Street and thank you to Mr. Driver and Mr. Johnson for 'driving' this one. Both buses will aim to leave at 8:15am and walk to school. Students can be picked up along the way. We also will be having a Free Coffee morning at school from 8.15-9.30am being provided by the Paynesville Neighbourhood House.

Enrolments for the 2026 school year are now open. If you, or someone you know has a child who will be attending school next year, please encourage them to contact the school for an enrolment pack as well as attending our Open Day next Wednesday 21st May. All classrooms will be open to visitors on this day, with tours by our school and house captains. It is also lovely to see parents and grandparents coming along if possible as well. Those families that live within our catchment zone of Eagle Point, Newlands Arm, Forge Creek, Wattle Point, Goon Nure etc. are guaranteed a place at the school. Applications from outside these areas can be considered if spaces are available so it is important for us to have an understanding of numbers before the end of Term 2. Presented by Laura Owen - Wildlife Unlimited



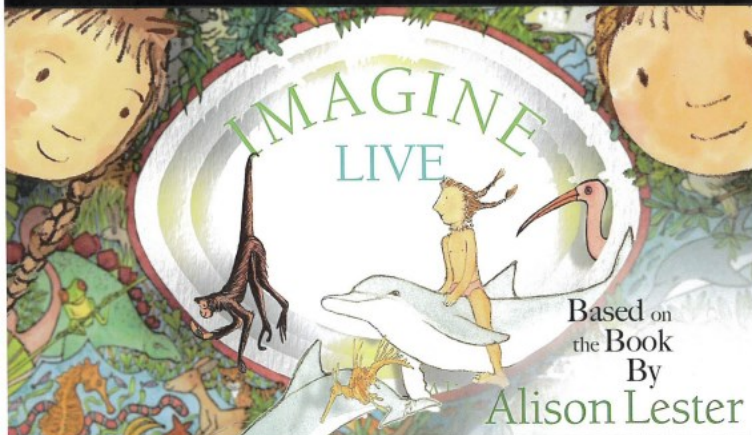
Laura will share knowledge about the nocturnal wildlife of Newlands Arm area. This will be followed by a walk in the Trust for Nature area.
